## Overview of Financial Assistance Schemes in Victoria School

Victoria School provides a series of financial assistance schemes (FAS) to needy students so that Victorians, regardless of their financial background, can benefit from best opportunities in education. These schemes include:

- (A) MOE FAS;
- (B) School-Based FAS and;
- (C) Victoria Advisory Committee (VAC) FAS.

### (A) MOE Financial Assistance Scheme

MOE FAS is to help needy Singaporean students to meet basic schooling expenses.

#### Eligibility Criteria for MOE FAS

The eligibility criteria for MOE FAS are as follows:

- The family's Gross Household Income (GHI) does not exceed \$3,000 per month; or
- The family's Per Capita Income (PCI) does not exceed \$750. PCI is computed based on GHI divided by the number of household members which include the student, his/her unmarried siblings, parents and grandparents living at the same address. Other relatives who are dependent on the family and live at the same residential address may be included on a case-by-case basis.

#### School Meals Programme

Students on the MOE FAS will receive subsidies for 10 meals per 5-day school week of \$3.50 per meal.

## (B) School-Based Financial Assistance Scheme

School-based FAS is to provide help to students who do not qualify for MOE FAS.

#### Eligibility Criteria for School-Based FAS

School will consider needy Singaporean students on application basis and the eligibility criteria are as follows:

- The family's Gross Household Income (GHI) does not exceed \$4,000 per month; or
- The family's Per Capita Income (PCI) does not exceed \$1,000. PCI is computed based on GHI divided by the number of household members which include the student, his/her unmarried siblings, parents and grandparents living at the same address. Other relatives who are dependent on the family and live at the same residential address may be included on a case-by-case basis.
